

Terms and Conditions

Acceptance of the Terms and Conditions:

Payment and participation

The Participant will be issued with a tax invoice after the Workshop Registration Form has been processed by NEA. All Participant fees must be paid in full no later than 20 working days prior to the course to guarantee and confirm registration.
